

Last Night's Council Meeting Update On Line 8 EA

Thank you Everyone who came out, wrote an email, phoned, texted or I had the pleasure of speaking with you either at your door or from your attendance last night.

I thank you for your patience and trust.

Last Night the EA was finally approved by council for the first time in over 20 years of work. The EA was approved in Principle with my amendment that was approved by majority of support by council in support of the residents effected living in between Barrie St and Noble Drive.

The EA in a whole is a Master plan to say you can build to this maximum space. But ultimately the detailed design will come back to council to approve the best design necessary in particular to this area Noble drive and Barrie Street. (which is essentially called the EAST END of Line 8)

The production of this Line 8 extension will be developed in 2 phases. The first phase will be the West end of Line and srd line 10 in 2026-2027 from Reagens Line 10 to REagens Line 8 and that will include the building of the roundabout and pedestrian walk lanes.

The second phase will deal with the East end of Line 8 and Barrie street in 2029-2030. Before construction can begin - staff will revisit the design options for the 2 westbound and 2 eastbound lanes and Lowes gate safety options.

This will mean the newest traffic, population growth, and transportation plans will help us decide if indeed the town is growing rapidly or has slowed completely. It will also give us an idea of how Line 8 is being used, has been used and if the expansion of Line 8 in particular at Barrie Street to Noble Drive future use of this roadway will deem for the residents and the use of the residents living in BWG.

I am extremely grateful for your trust and support - I will continue to advocate on your behalf and I am looking forward to the new staff report that was requested last night to fix email correspondence updates being given to residents on matters that they sign up for. This is a gap that needs to be fixed and I believe it will be in the near future.
